#### **GENERAL**

#### **CONTRACT TIME AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:**

(7-20-99) (Rev. 12-18-07)

SP1 G04

The date of availability for this contract is **November 1, 2010**, except that work in jurisdictional waters and wetlands shall not begin until a meeting between the DOT, Regulatory Agencies, and the Contractor is held as stipulated in the permits contained elsewhere in this proposal. This delay in availability has been considered in determining the contract time for this project.

The completion date for this contract is **November 1, 2012**.

Except where otherwise provided by the contract, observation periods required by the contract will not be a part of the work to be completed by the completion date and/or intermediate contract times stated in the contract. The acceptable completion of the observation periods that extend beyond the final completion date shall be a part of the work covered by the performance and payment bonds.

The liquidated damages for this contract are Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00) per calendar day.

#### INTERMEDIATE CONTRACT TIME NUMBER 1 AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

The Contractor shall complete the required work of installing, maintaining, and removing the traffic control devices for lane closures and restoring traffic to a 2-lane, 2-way traffic pattern. The Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on –L- (US -17) during the following time restrictions:

#### **DAY AND TIME RESTRICTIONS**

Monday through Friday from 6:30A.M. to 8:30 A.M.

and

Monday through Friday 4:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.

In addition, the Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on -L- (US 17), detain and/or alter the traffic flow on or during holidays, holiday weekends, special events, or any other time when traffic is unusually heavy, including the following schedules:

#### HOLIDAY AND HOLIDAY WEEKEND LANE CLOSURE RESTRICTIONS

1. For **unexpected occurrence** that creates unusually high traffic volumes, as directed by the Engineer.

## PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISIONS Utility By Others

#### **UTILITY CONFLICTS:**

General:

The following utility companies have facilities that will be in conflict with the construction of this project:

- A. PROGRESS ENERGY-POWER
- B. CENTURY LINK-TELEPHONE
- C. SUDDEN LINK-CABLE

The conflicting facilities of these concerns will be adjusted prior to the date of availability, unless otherwise noted and are therefore listed in these special provisions for the benefit of the Contractor. All utility work listed herein will be done by the utility owners. All utilities are shown on the plans from the best available information.

The Contractor's attention is directed to Article 105.8 of the Standard Specifications.

Utilities Requiring Adjustment:

#### A. Progress Energy

The Contractor's attention is directed to the fact that Progress Energy has conflicts within the project limits. The primary conflicts are shown on plan sheet UO-4. Progress Energy will complete temporary work that will permit construction access by March 1, 2011. During this temporary phase, the Contractor will be required to work around several poles that may be in conflict with construction.

Permanent work to completely clear Progress Energy conflicts will be completed by June 15, 2011.
